

Whakamana te Waituna work programme 2019

During the 2019 year we aim to:

Monitoring and Evaluation framework.

- Develop monitoring and evaluation programme reporting social, cultural and biophysical changes from intervention that can give finer scale information to farmers and land managers.
- Work with the community to develop and finalise project plan to achieve contaminant reduction on and off farm
- Work with those willing to initiate on and off farm programme including peak run-off structures, sediment traps, wetlands, nutrient filters, undertake farm plans
- Set up demonstration sites with contaminant intervention structures (hopefully 10)

Community Engagement

- Facilitate the function of community-led processes (including at least two workshops and at least two field days) to make environmental improvements (sediment and nutrient reduction) on and off farm.
